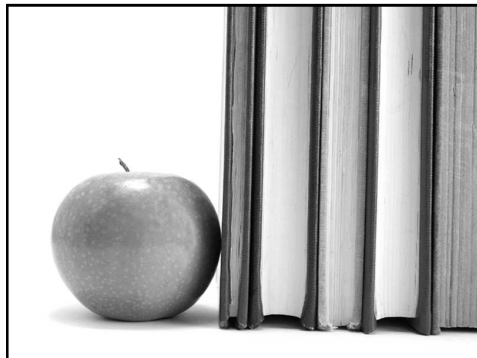

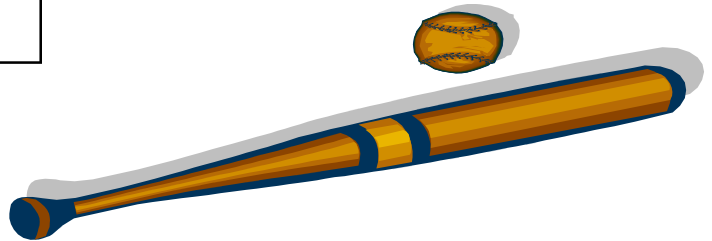


Ms. Roper is excited to be a part of Carman Trails, and we are glad that she is our teacher.


