Kindergarten

1. Backpack or totebag
2. Labels in all jackets, sweaters, coats, etc.
3. Painting smock which can be an old t-shirt or blouse
4. One bottle of Elmer's **white** glue (no colors)
5. Large pencil box, cigar box, or lunch box to hold supplies
6. Set of **fat** colored markers (set of 8)
7. Scissors (Fiskars pointed work best)
8. Box of tissues
9. 1 2-Pocket folder (no vertical pockets) for take home papers
10. Three - 10x8 spiral notebooks with 70 pages wide lines
11. 2 rolls of **Bounty** paper towels
12. Beach towel for full-day
13. Crayons - 8 or 16 pack
14. Lysol Wipes
15. Ziplock sandwich or gallon size bags
16. 2 large **white glue sticks**
17. Hand wipes (1/2 day only)

Second Grade

7. Paint shirt (labeled with child's name)
8. 4 two-pocket folders (no Trapper Keepers)

7. 3 10 ½ x 8 spiral notebooks, 70 pages, wide ruled
8. 1 box **washable** fine point markers (optional)
9. 10 #2 plain yellow pencils (not mechanical)

COMMUNITY SUPPLIES (TO BE GIVEN TO TEACHER; NOT LABELED)

10. 2 dry erase markers

4th and 5th Grade Orchestra

1. Rent or buy an instrument. Attach a luggage tag with your student's name on the handle.
2. One 1" three ring binder with pockets on the inside front and back cover. 5th Grade may use theirs from last year if it is in good shape. 5th grade needs to keep their 4th grade music. We refer back to it periodically.
3. 25 **non glare** plastic sheet protectors for 4th grade. 5th grade needs 20.
4. Pencil pouch with holes for binder
5. 4 highlighters of various colors for 4th grade. 5th graders do not need them.
6. 2 sharpened pencils
7. 1 extra fine point black Sharpie
8. Small packet of Post-Its
9. Folding music stand for home practice.
Shoulder rest. Muco, Kun, Viva and Resonant are all good brands. For a less expensive option, you can order the black "Loft Sponge" at www.theloftviolinshop.com. This is the black contoured sponge that we use in third grade. Please don't buy a memory foam sponge. Make sure the shoulder rest or sponge matches the size of your instrument
