Career Shadowing Opportunities

In January, STLCC hosted Lafayette High School junior Mackenzie Hackman for a career shadowing opportunity through the Rockwood school district. The visits expose the students to as many aspects of the career as possible, and the professionals expand the students' awareness of the chosen career path. Students are encouraged to ask questions and learn as much as possible during their visit. Hackman shadowed Kim Granger, a full-time mathematics instructor on the Wildwood campus. This is the second year in a row that one of Wildwood's faculty members participated in the program.



Rockwood ACT Day

On April 24, the Rockwood School District will be administering a district-wide ACT for juniors. STLCC will be making informational presentations at Rockwood Summit and Lafayette High Schools for the sophomore classes. We will cover topics such as choosing a college, steps in the application process and "life after high school."
