

Just a bit of Pierremont History

When Pierremont Elementary School opened its doors in 1967, a barn and farmhouse surrounded by pastures stood just beyond the kindergarten fences. Expansions came rapidly as the farm was sold to make way for new homes. In 1990-91, Pierremont reached its highest enrollment with 734 students. In the spring of 1995, Pierremont said goodbye to the sixth grade class, as it was absorbed into the new middle school configuration. Today, Pierremont educates students from kindergarten through fifth grade.
