

University of Missouri System Admission Requirements

Regular admission of college students graduating from high school requires completion of at least seventeen units of credit as follows:

4 Credits of English One unit may be in speech or debate. Two units emphasizing composition or writing skills are required. For example: English or Language Arts 9, 10, 11, 12. English Literature, Speech, Debate I, etc. Not acceptable: Yearbook, Acting, Theater, Drama, Multimedia.

4 Credits of Mathematics* (Algebra I and higher). For example: Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, Algebra 2/Trigonometry, Pre-Calculus, Calculus, etc. Not acceptable: Pre-Algebra, Algebra Lab, Accounting, AP Computer Science A.

3 Credits of Social Studies

For example: World History, American History, American Government, Challenges to Democracy, Psychology, Sociology, Economics, etc.

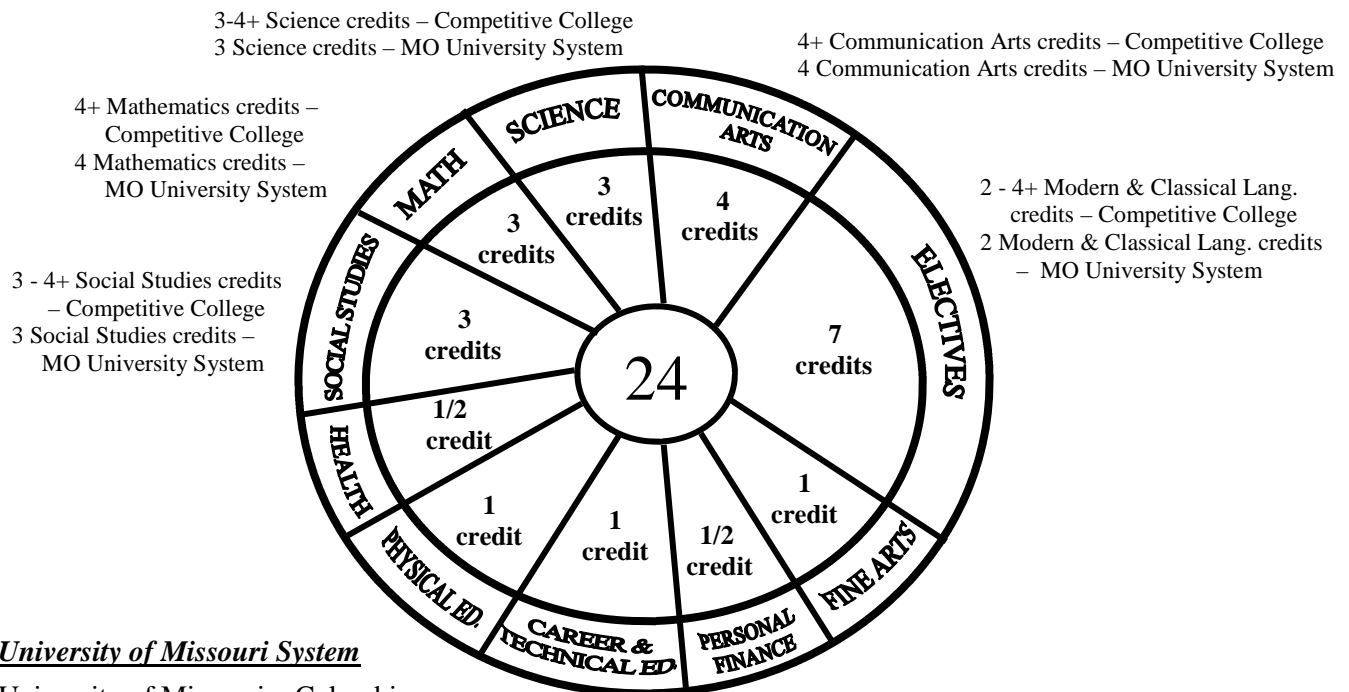
3 Credits of Science* One unit must be a laboratory course. For example: Earth Science, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, etc.

2 Credits of Foreign Language* (same language)

1 Credit of Fine Art

* This requirement may be satisfied by the completion of courses in middle school, junior high school, or senior high school.
