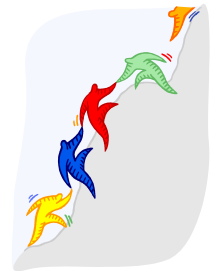


General Information

The Parkway South Service Learning program provides students and alternative educational experience to work in the community as either an intern or as a volunteer. As an intern, a student would explore the real demands and challenges of a prospective career. As a community service volunteer, a student would utilize his or her talents and energies to benefit the community. Service Learning complements and enriches the strong academic program at South High and makes school meaningful in a real world context.

FAQS:

- The Service Learning class allows students to either work as a non-paid intern or as a volunteer community service worker.
- The grade is pass/fail.
- The class earns an elective credit.



PROCESS TO GET ENROLLED IN SERVICE LEARNING!

- BE CLASSIFIED AS A SENIOR BY AUGUST OF YOUR SENIOR YEAR.
- NEED TWO CREDITS OR LESS FOR GRADUATION.
- EARNED A 2.5 OR HIGHER CAREER GPA.
- RECEIVED NO "U'S" IN CITIZENSHIP AND NO MORE THAN ONE "I" OVER YOUR HIGH SCHOOL CAREER.
- HAVE NO UNEXCUSED ABSENCES.
- CAN PROVIDE OWN TRANSPORTATION TO EXPERIENCE (DOES NOT GUARANTEE PARKING SPOT AT SOUTH).
- HAVE PARENTAL PERMISSION.
- ARRANGE FOR OWN INTERSHIP OR COMMUNITY SERVICE NO LATER THAN THE SECOND MONDAY OF THE SEMESTER COMPLETEING SERVICE LEARNING.
 - **Note:** students may not change their cooperating site during the semester. Students who do not have a site or attempt to change will receive an F in the course.

PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR SERVICE LEARNING

Once a student is enrolled in the course, in order to earn a passing grade they must do ALL of the following:

- 1) Attending all service learning meetings through out the semester.
- 2) Maintain a daily journal for each day you visit your site. Journals will be picked from a list given to the student from Mrs. Belding at the beginning of the year meeting.
- 3) Keep a time log and obtain supervisors signatures for each day.
- 4) Obtain an evaluation from your supervisor at the conclusion of the course.
- 5) Complete a minimum of 60 hours by 1 week prior to the end of the semester (Approximately 4-5 hours per week).
- 6) Meet all the expectations of the on-site supervisor and the faculty supervisor.
- 7) Create and present a 10 minute presentation at the conclusion of the course. Presentation will be given to faculty supervisor and on-site supervisor.

NOTE: *Students who are enrolled in the A+ Schools Program and have ALL required paperwork on file will be able to earn 25 hours of community service towards the 50 hour tutoring/ mentoring/ community service requirement.*
