## ADVANCED PLACEMENT

Advanced Placement (AP) is a program of college-level courses or examinations for secondary school students. In AP courses students learn about a subject in greater detail and develop analytical and study skills that contribute to success at the college level. Taking the three-hour AP examination in May can help students in the following ways:

1. Exemption from beginning courses
2. Entrance to higher level courses
3. College credit awarded
4. Time and money saved by receiving sophomore standing for AP credit earned

For more information concerning Advanced Placement, contact your counseling department. Courses following the Advanced Placement curriculum are noted in the course descriptions. In addition, students are urged to contact the college they plan to attend concerning its policy on acceptance of AP credit.

## DUAL CREDIT PROGRAMS

*Clarifying comment on the number of courses possible: Five courses shall be assured in transfer to all public institutions and independent/proprietary signatory institutions. "Equivalence of five courses" means five individual courses, regardless of the credit-hour value of those courses. [Adopted June, 1999, Missouri Coordinating Board For Higher Education]*

Parkway South in cooperation with local universities, colleges, and junior colleges offers opportunities to receive college credit. UMSL and St. Louis University require a career GPA of 3.0 or higher to participate in the Dual Credit Program. The student should contact the high school counselor for additional information on these programs and the registrar of a particular college or university for credit transfer information.
