Dear South High Community:

I hope you enjoyed the Thanksgiving break with your family. My wife and I were fortunate enough to have both of our adult children home to spend the entire holiday weekend together. Now that both sons are beginning their working careers out of the St. Louis area I am certainly thankful for the opportunity for us to be together. It is still difficult for me to accept that I'm old enough to have twenty-six and twenty-three year old sons who work and earn their own income. For those of you who, like me, also have adult children, you can relate to how quickly time flies. For those parents with first-time high school students, stay involved and active in the lives of your children. You will cherish these times as some of the best ever.

Recently I learned that Preferred Family Healthcare (PFH) and the Parkway School District have partnered to offer students, families and staff of South High and our two feeder middle schools a substance use prevention program. This program is funded through a generous grant from the St. Louis County Children's Services Fund. We are still working out the details and hope to begin some services by mid-January. Areas of services offered to our students and families include student and community awareness presentations and activities, individual and family counseling and individual intensive education programming. I am thankful and optimistic this will be a wonderful addition to our school program and look forward to working with PFH.

Last week I was reminded of the many outstanding co-curricular programs teachers offer at South. I attended the First Tech Challenge robotics competition at Florissant Valley Community College. Because our students find that experience valuable and rewarding, we entered three teams in the competition. Of the 28 teams competing two of our teams knocked off their opponents in the semi-final matches, resulting in a final competition of South High only teams. What impressed me most was the teamwork and how new friendship circles developed within each of the teams. It is always nice to sweep the finals, but those life lessons and skills learned during the weeks of design and construction are what our students will remember most. Congratulations and thanks to Robotics Club sponsors Tim Morrison and John Koski for the many hours they donated preparing our students for the competition and beyond. On another note, I attended our winter vocal music concert last week. A large audience attended and I felt their engagement with the music. The level of talent was amazing. The selections performed ranged from light-hearted and fun to technical and beautiful. The students had one month to memorize and master all new music since their last performance, a testament to their teacher Jonathan Owen and an abundance of student talent. Please consider attending one of our upcoming shows performed by South High's band and orchestra. Even if you don't have a child performing, it is a great opportunity to make a night of dinner and music and experience the sense of pride I feel every day at South High.

Finally, I wish everyone a joyous and safe holiday season. The adults at South have personal knowledge of South High families and colleagues who have recently lost a family member and our thoughts are with them. Please remember our school community's families whose relatives and friends are away serving in the military or struggling due to the economy. We are all blessed in some way and struggle in others; it's good to be in a supportive community where we can lean on each other. I hope we can all take time to be reminded of what we have and help those in need. All of us at South wish you a safe and happy holiday season.

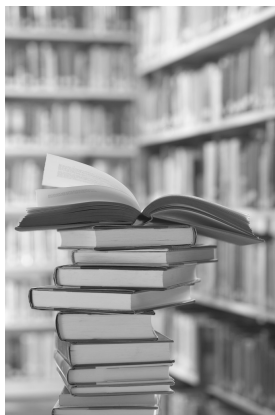

## **2012 - 2013 PARKING PERMITS**

**Parking is restricted to senior and junior students only.**

### **IMPORTANT DATES:**

If you would like to be considered for a parking permit:

- **Class of '13** – Senior applications will be available in the bookstore from **Monday, January 9, 2012** through **Friday, February 3, 2012**. The \$75 parking fee for seniors is due at the time the application is submitted. Any senior not submitting an application during the Senior application period will have their application placed in the lottery with the junior applications.
- **Class of '14** – Junior applications will be available in the bookstore from **Monday, February 6, 2012** through **Friday, March 2, 2012**. Juniors are required to share a parking space with another junior. Student driving partners must each complete an individual application and submit the two applications at the same time. The \$75 fee for juniors is due when the students pick up their permits, usually the week before school starts.



### **IMPORTANT REQUIREMENTS:**

The cost for a parking permit is \$75. Students will need to have their student ID with them when they go to the bookstore to pick up an application. All fines and fees must be paid in full before receiving a parking application. In addition, students will need approval from their administrator and the library to be considered for a parking permit. Excessive absences (excused or unexcused), tardies and inappropriate behavior will be determining factors in the application process. Spaces are assigned randomly from approved applications. Senior applications submitted after the February 3, 2012 deadline will be placed in the lottery with the junior applications. Senior and Junior applications submitted after March 2, 2012 will be placed on a waiting list. For more information, please contact Ms. Melinda O'Shea 314-415-7704. # COUNSELING NEWS

## Seniors

Now is the time to:

- Complete all applications for college admissions. Applications with January 1 deadlines must be turned in to your counselor before finals begin.
- Make sure you ask your counselor to have your transcripts sent to the schools to which you've applied.
- Contact the financial aid offices of your colleges to determine eligibility and apply for financial aid and scholarships.

Check the counseling page on South High's website ([www.pshwired.net](http://www.pshwired.net)) for Scholarship Opportunities or talk to Mrs. Gerike in the College & Career Center.

- Check to see if your college(s) requires a Mid-Year Report showing senior year first semester grades. If so, talk with your counselor.
- Visit [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) to begin completing your FAFSA form for financial aid. Parents and students both need PIN numbers which can be ordered ahead of time.
- Once your final college selection is made, complete and return your housing deposit.

Remember that college acceptance is provisional until your college reviews completed grades and your final schedule. Do not make schedule changes unless approved by your college.

## Juniors

Junior year is a good time to start thinking about plans for after graduation from high school. Our counselors met with juniors through their English classes during the month of November. We discussed post-high school options and explored Family Connection, an online resource for college and career planning. Please ask your child to share this information with you. Students who were absent are encouraged to make an appointment with their counselor to get this much needed information. The PSAT test results should arrive at South in the middle of December. Announcements will be made for students to see their counselor to pick up these results and an interpretation of the results.

We encourage all juniors to take the ACT or SAT college entrance exam at least one time before their senior year. **All juniors will be taking the ACT test during the school day on April 24.** There will be **no charge** for this test. Detailed information will be sent out at a later date.

Please note: Beginning next fall with the class of 2013, South High will no longer be including ACT scores with the transcripts we send to colleges. Many colleges are no longer accepting test scores from high schools and will only accept them from the testing agency (ACT or SAT). When registering to take the ACT students can indicate up to 4 colleges where they would like their scores sent free of charge. Changes can be made to that list at no charge up to 12 noon central time the Thursday immediately after the regularly scheduled Saturday test date. Additional schools can be added for a fee. If you don't indicate schools before taking the test, you can request the scores to be sent however, there is a \$10 fee per college. *To avoid paying this fee, students should plan ahead and list four colleges they might be considering at the time of registering for the ACT.* If you have questions please visit [www.actstudent.org](http://www.actstudent.org) or speak with your counselor or Mrs. Ruth Gerike in the College & Career Center.

## Sophomores

PLAN test scores should be arriving at South soon and our counselors will be presenting results to students during December. The PLAN test is a strong predictor of success on the ACT and also includes a career exploration component. During our meeting with sophomores we will also be introducing them to Family Connection and exploring a career interest inventory that can be helpful for students as they think about options for the future.

## Freshmen

All 9<sup>th</sup> graders met with our counseling staff during first semester. The topic was how to be successful in high school. We encouraged all students to take their academics seriously and to get involved in a sport or club at South High. Students who are involved in school do better academically and report that they enjoy school more. Students were also introduced to Family Connection, a program students can use to research colleges and careers.

If your child is struggling in a class, please talk with his or her classroom teacher about ways to get help. Many students need help in getting organized and using their time wisely. AcLab is an excellent time for students to see their teachers when in need of assistance. Most students who are struggling in a class report to their counselor that they are not regularly seeing their teacher for assistance.

## **VARSITY SOFTBALL TEAM**

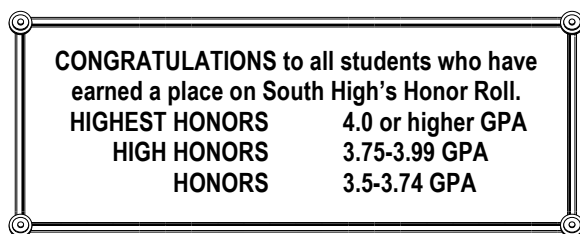

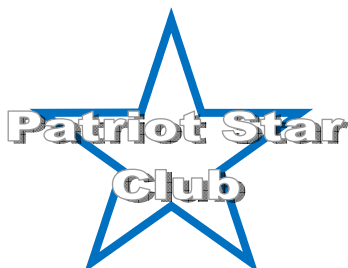

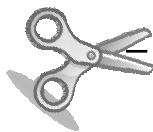
